Because of the winter storm we had on Tuesday this week, the Public Hearing at the Legislative Office Building in Hartford for SB 435 has been re-scheduled to tomorrow, Thursday March 15th, 2018 at 10AM in Room 310.

The Fire Marshals ask that we join them as they oppose a <u>SB-435</u> - AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE AND USE OF CONSUMER GRADE FIREWORKS. You can submit written and oral testimony. If you would like to submit oral testimony, please contact me as soon as possible:

Written testimony needs to be in word or PDF format and emailed to <u>gltestimony@cga.ct.gov</u>. Testimony should clearly state testifier name and related Bills. The Committee requests that testimony be limited to matters related to the items on the Agenda. The first hour of the hearing is reserved for Legislators, Constitutional Officers, State Agency Heads and Chief Elected Municipal Officials. Speakers will be limited to three minutes of testimony.
